Over the last year, WITTENSTEIN has released the LP+ Generation 3 as the successor to the most-installed planetary gearhead in motion control today, the LP+.

The LP+ Generation 3 is a direct dimensional replacement for existing LP+ gearheads and has an increase in performance over the existing LP+. New materials and enhancements in gearing allow for higher torque density, lower backlash, and lower operating noise level in comparison to its predecessor.

The existing LP+ will begin the phase out process on October 1st, 2013 and transition to legacy pricing. The LP+ Generation 3 will maintain the existing LP+ pricing, while receiving a performance improvement to provide enhanced value.
